The Employer

Johanniter-Unfall-Hilfe e.V. is a humanitarian organization operating in the health and social care sectors. It was founded in 1952 in Hannover and is affiliated with the Brandenburg Bailiwick of the Order of St John, the German Protestant descendant of the Knights Hospitaller. JUH participates in international aid efforts together with its sister organizations in other countries as part of the Johanniter International partnership; it also works with the German Malteser Hilfsdienst, affiliated to the Catholic Sovereign Military Order of Malta. As of 2017 the organization had 37,000 active volunteers and youth members and around 1,300,000 registered members.

The organization is currently looking for childcare professionals to supervise and educate children aged 0-3 and 3-6 years. Educators will work in JUH nurseries and kindergartens located in Bavaria. Requirements include very good German knowledge (at least B2), a degree in child care and a talent for working with children.

How does it work?

During the recruitment day, representatives from the organization will come to Rome to present the job opportunity and interview the candidates. An Adviser from *Your first EURES job - ReActivate* team will provide information about the possibility to apply for financial benefits within the EU Projects.

Successful candidates will receive a pre-contract/letter of intent and will be given time to learn German before moving to Germany. They will also be involved in an integration programme and induction training both in the pre-departure and in the post-placement phase.
